First of all, let me inform you that THE HOME FOR ABANDONED CHILDREN that is being constructed in Dr. Carlson's memory, is well on its way in spite of a serious drought that India is experiencing at this time. We are so grateful for the funds that have come in to make possible the building of this wonderfully practical memorial. Of course this is not meant to be an elaborate or costly monument to Dr. Carlson. It is actually intended to be a building that can be used to care for little children who have been forsaken and abandoned. We desire only an adequate practical facility that will bring glory to our God. THE MOTHER CARLSON MEMORIAL HOSPITAL has

now been in operation for more than a year, and how we do praise the Lord for the blessing and benefit that is being realized from this most worthy project. In this hospital 50 to 60 crippled children can be adequately cared for, and wonderful reports are reaching our Mission to Children office, telling of successful surgeries on deformed and crippled limbs that have been corrected, and these precious boys and girls are now able to walk for the (Continued on Page 2)

TEENS TODAY

FOUR STAGES OF TEEN DRUG ABUSE

(We are grateful to Dr. Joseph R. Novello, the Director of the Gateway Rehabilitation Program in Washington, D.C. for this most informative article on the stages of drug abuse. Our teens and parents of young people have asked our Mission to Children staif to provide current information on this plague that is taking over our youth—drug abuse.)

The world of adolescent alcohol and drug abuse is not a pretty one. It is marked by pain, deceit, dashed hopes, and wasted lives. Chemical dependency, the name we give it, is an illness that can kill. Like other chronic illnesses, chemical dependency develops in stages. Recognizing the early stages is crucial to intervention and treatment because the signs are not always readily apparent. Complicating the problem is the fact that many parents tend to have an instinctive denial mechanism: A usual reaction from such a parent is "not my child," or "he's just going through a stage."

STAGE 1: EXPERIMENTATION

Alcohol and drugs are everywhere. No teenager is immune from experimentation—it is usually a result of peer pressure. Most high school students have tried alcohol and marijuana. Fortunately, for most kids, it stops right there. Those fortunate young people try it and forget it. Some never try it again. Others continue to dabble in small amounts, never going beyond this stage. But there are other young people who try it and like it. Why are some more susceptible? We don't have all the answers. Family influence and genetics are part of the reason, along with depression or the urge for peer acceptance. These teens don't remain experimenters.

STAGE 2: ACTIVE SEEKING

Not content to wait around for his next high, the teen goes looking for it. "Partying," as young people call it, is limited to weekends at first. Some young people, like social drinkers, can arrest their drug use at this stage, but close to 10 percent can't and don't. Soon their use spreads over the entire week. Curiously, their behavior at home and even their performance in class may not be noticeably affected. Armed with breath fresheners, eye drops and growing skills at deception, they continue to fool those around them.

STAGE THREE: PREOCCUPATION

The teenager is now preoccupid with getting high and begins to plan his life around it. Behavior is erratic. Grades usually suffer. If Mom finds a joint in his pocket, he'll claim he is "just holding it for a friend." If Dad pushes the matter, his son will deny he has a drug problem. If his parents suggest counseling, the teenager will threaten to run away—or he will admit to a few "experiments" with pot but nothing more. But it is probably more than pot now; most likely he has graduated to other substances: cocaine, PCP, and LSD.

STAGE 4: ADDICTION

It is not fun anymore. The teen is drunk, high, stoned or buzzed most of the time. Tolerance develops, and he is doing a lot more of the same substance just to maintain a hazy equilibrium. It's more expensive too. How to pay for it? Stealing is one way. Drug-dealing is another. For girls, prostitution can be the grisly answer. Left untreated, the Stage 4 adolescent faces a grim future. We tell newly admitted patients to our drug rehabilitation program that they have three choices: They can get locked up (jailed), covered up (an early death), or sobered up. Treatment is tough work. It takes courage and commitment from the teenager and his family. The goal is complete acceptance of a sober lifestyle.

EDITOR'S NOTE:

YOUNG PERSON: Do you recognize yourself or any of your friends in this preceding article? If you do, don't waste any more time. Your life can be salvaged. Early treatments may guarantee better results for recovery.

PARENTS: Don't delay! Solicit help! Even though your child may threaten and curse, remember, that is the "illness" speaking and reacting. When your child comes to the place where he realizes his drastic need for help, and that you have rescued his very life, he will one day not only thank you for it, but also express thanksgiving to the Lord for answering the prayers of his parents.



RECIPE FOR A HAPPY NEW YEAR IN 1987

The time has come for us to pause and reflect. As we reminisce and look back over the past 12 months, we are filled with mixed emotions of joy and sadness. Praise comes to our lips as we contemplate the longsuffering and faithfulness of God in bringing us thus far. But there are also feelings of regret. Realizing that we cannot undo the wrongs of yesterday, our mistakes and sins would cause us to hang our heads in shame were it not for our all-forgiving God who loves us and cares for us. Yes, the book of another year, 1986, has been sealed, and we cannot rewrite its pages. They are now history.

As we stand on the threshold of another brand new year and are determined to make necessary adjustments and improvements in various ways in 1987, may I share with you a scrapbook recipe that promises to help provide a joyous and happy new year? It is my prayer that when 1987 has run its course, you will be able to say, "Truly these have been 365 wonderful days filled with joy, happiness, and rich blessings from the Lord."

RECIPE FOR A HAPPY NEW YEAR

Take twelve fine, full-grown months, see that these are thoroughly free irom all old memories of bitterness, rancor, hate, and jealousy; cleanse them completely from every clinging spite; pick off all specks of pettiness and littleness, in short, see that these months are freed from all the past—have them as fresh and clean as when they first came from the great storehouse of Time.

Cut these months into thirty or thirty-one equal parts. This batch will keep for just one year. Do not attempt to make up the whole batch at one time (so many persons spoil the entire lot in this way) but prepare one day at a time, as follows:

Into each day put twelve parts of faith, eleven of patience, ten of courage, nine of work (some people omit this ingredient and so spoil the flavor of the rest), eight of hope, seven of fidelity, six of liberality, five of kindness, four of rest (leaving this out is like leaving the oil out of the salad—don't do it), three of prayer, two of meditation, and one well-selected resolution. If you have no conscientious scruples, put in about a teaspoonful of good and pleasant disposition, a dash of laughter, a pinch of gaity, a sprinkling of fun, and a cupful of good humor.

Pour freely into the above mentioned mixture a liberal and generous amount of love, blending and stirring enthusiastically with much vim and vigor. Cook thoroughly in a fervent heat. Garnish with frequent friendly smiles and a sprig of joy. Serve with quietness, unselfishness, tenderness, and cheerfulness and the warmth of the love of Christ that only He can impart; and a happy new year will be an inevitable certainty and reality for 1987.

- 8. IF YOU HAVE PREPARATION TO MAKE—DO IT NOW.
- IF YOU HAVE CHILDREN TO TRAIN—TRAIN THEM TO-DAY.
- 10. IF YOU HAVE A GIFT TO GIVE-DO IT NOW.
